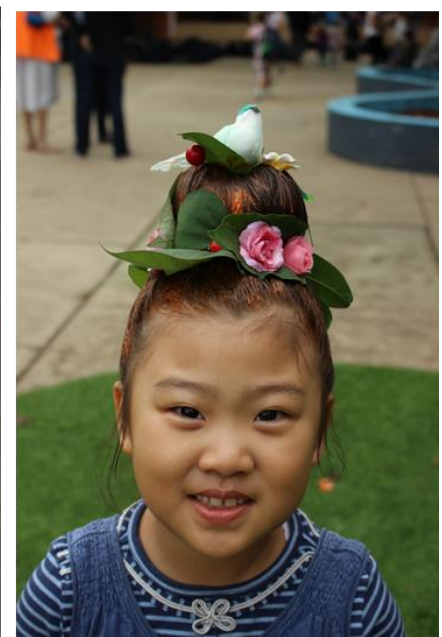


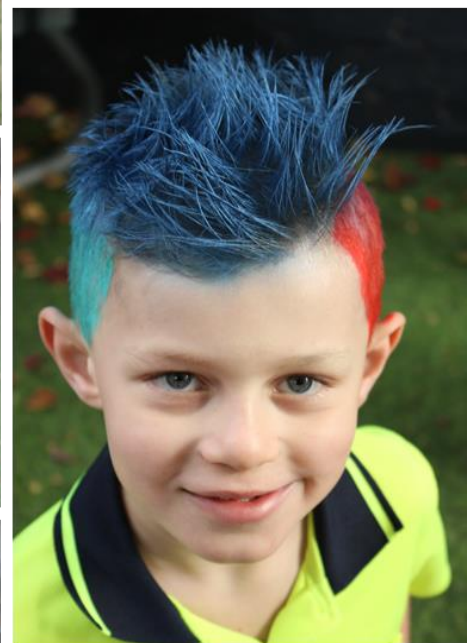
Every year we are amazed how the students (and parents) come up with such amazing new Crazy Hair Day hair styles. This year is no exception!



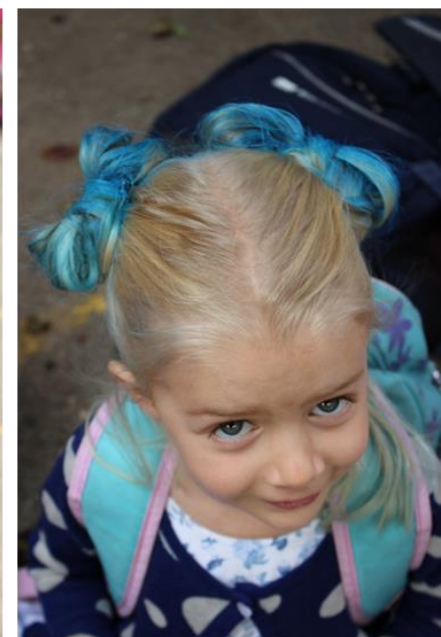
Well done to all the students that joined in Crazy Hair Day and contributed a gold coin donation to help raise money for the Leukemia Foundations, World's Greatest Shave.
