Tour objectives:

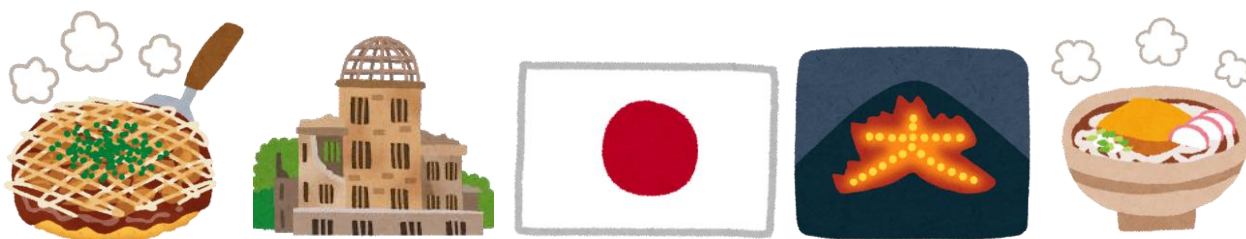
- \* To immerse students in Japanese language and culture.

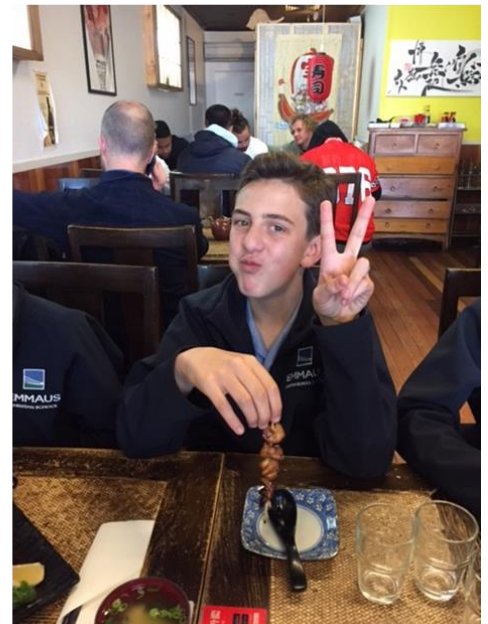
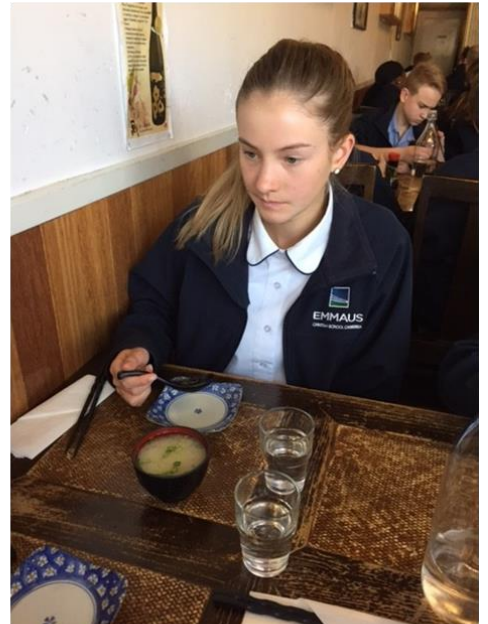


## Year 7 Japanese Excursion – Kagawa Restaurant in Dickson
