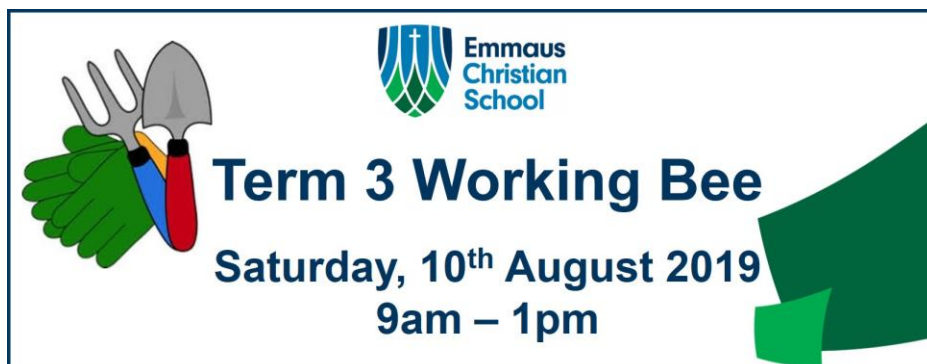

### STEP 1.

### STEP 3.

Carefully follow the steps to place your individual order.

Note: Nickname/s will be printed exactly as typed, so check spelling and upper/lowercase carefully. You will be able to log back in and change your size and order details up until your order deadline date. As your garment is completely customised, we do not offer exchanges or refunds.

### STEP 4.

Pay for your order online using a credit or debit card. The jerseys will cost **\$84**.

Students will need to try on the sample jerseys at school to determine their correct size before making their order. They will need to decide on their first or last name on the back and enter this on the ordering system. All orders will need to be approved by the school before they are ordered so please make sure that the sizes and names are correct (nicknames may not be approved). If cost is an issue, please let us know so that we can discuss possible payment options. Jersey ordering will need to be finalized on the online portal by the **23<sup>rd</sup> August**.

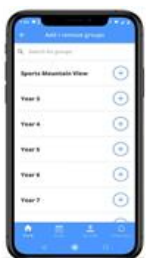

In all of this we give thanks to the LORD, for He is good; His love for Emmaus endures forever.







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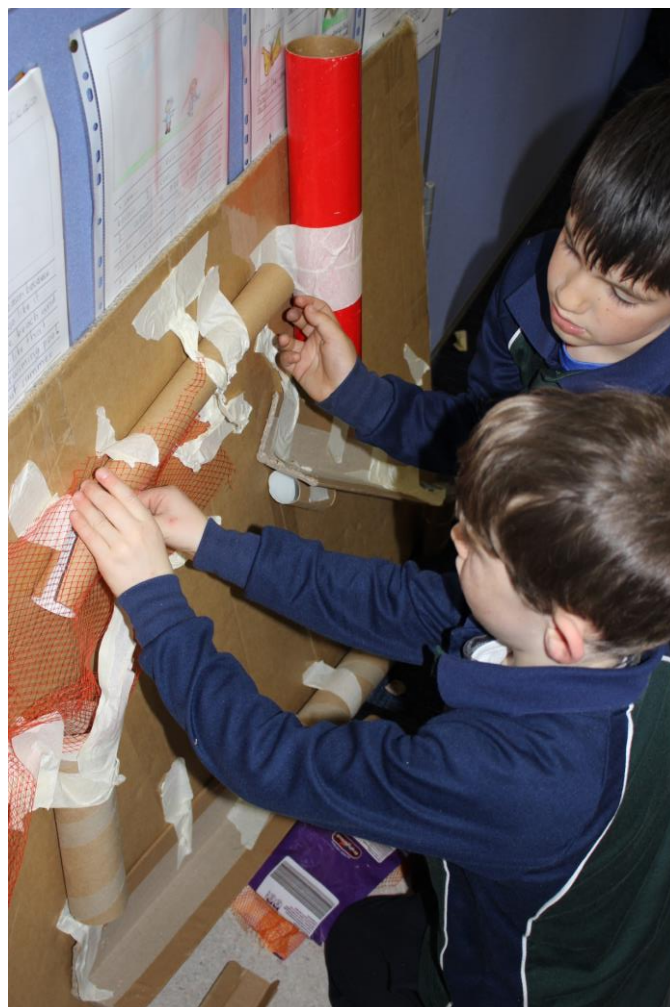




Year 1&2 Recycling Challenge: in groups of 2-3 create a toy for the courtyard.
