Stand 6:	Navigation	Taking a bearing
Stand 7:	Movement	Bear crawl to finish line

The Army will also return with some of the kid's favourites including Mog and Bushmaster vehicles, Treasure hunting in the sand pit and Obstacle courses (timed and untimed).

There will be a briefing on each stand and how to do things on the night with personnel spread around the course to assist.

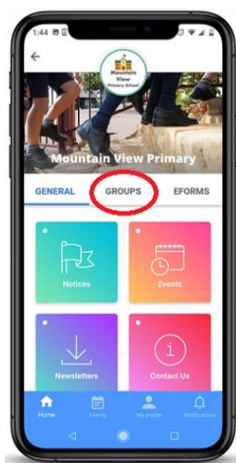

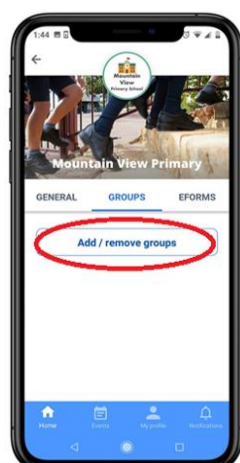

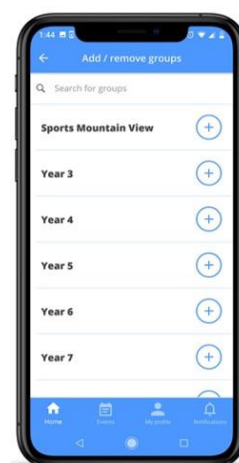

- Any other interesting facts or information you found interesting and think worth sharing.





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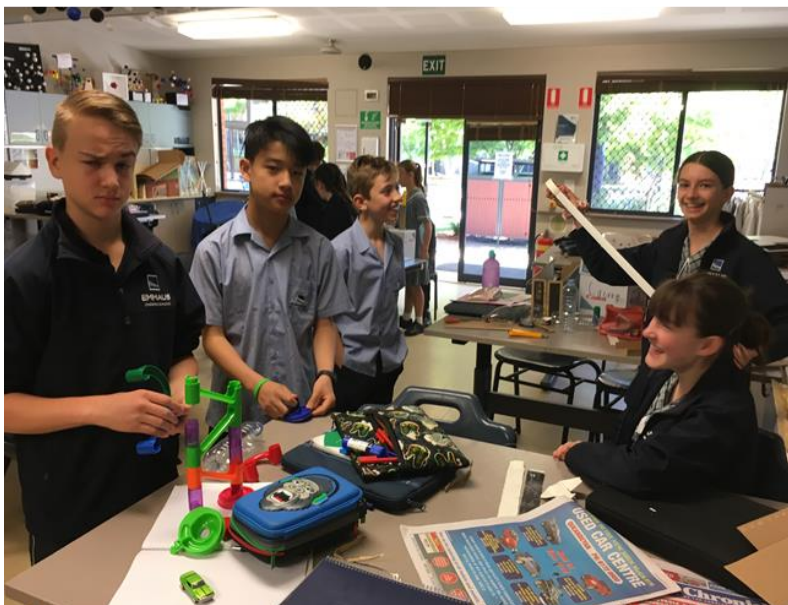
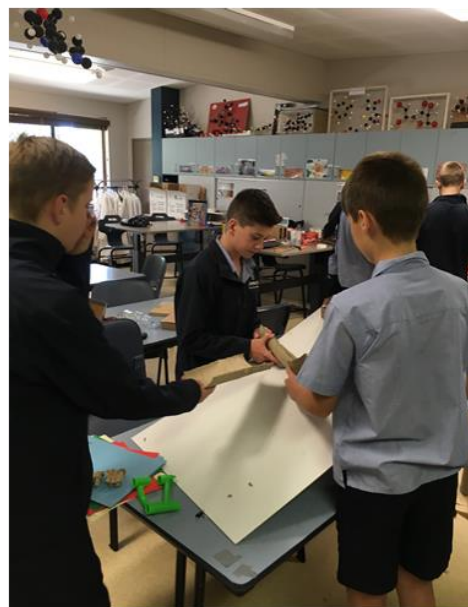
