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## Preschool Artwork – Exploring Castle Shapes

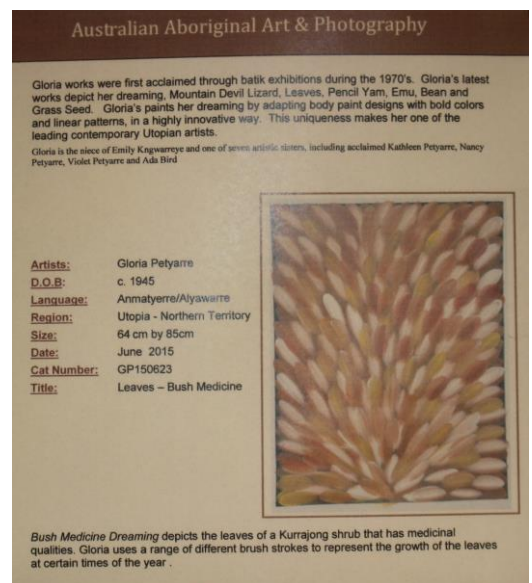

Recently Preschool students tried their hand at painting a replica of the painting and did an amazing job.



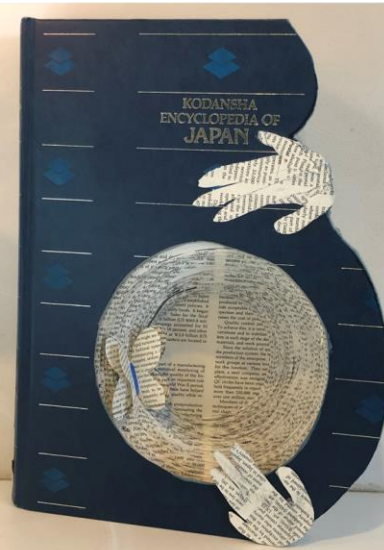
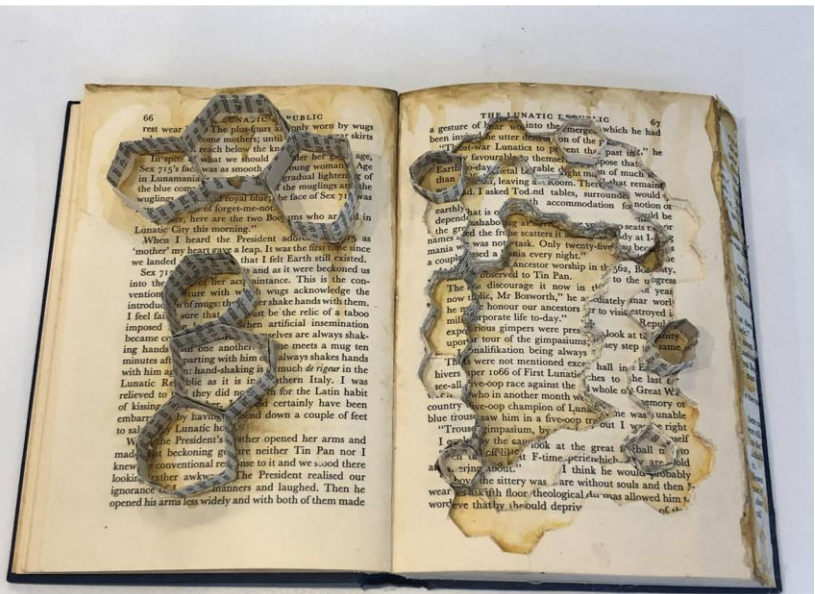
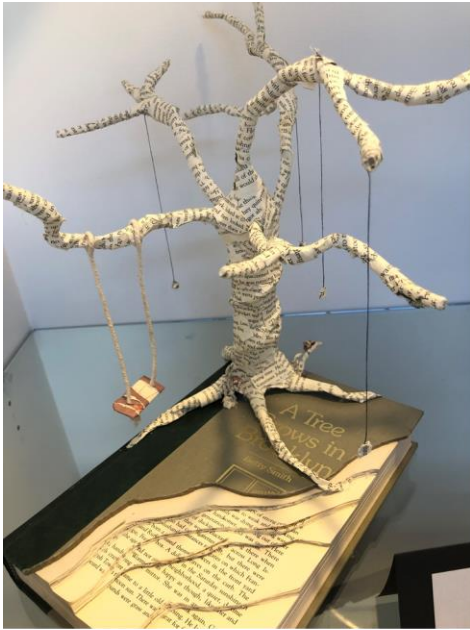
